#### PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING

Before I buy something in the store, I normally read the label. If it is an article of clothing, I want to check what it is made of (I don't like 100% man-made material, like polyester). If it is something to eat, I like to know how many calories, what is the fat and sodium content (the “bad” things”) as well as the vitamins and minerals contained in the item. Some labels are very helpful.

There are other types of labels as well. The kinds of labels that are used to describe a person, a way of acting or thinking. We use them all the time, especially in trying to define ourselves, in comparison to another person, belief or way of thinking. Labels that prove that “I” am different or “contrary” to “you” or your way of thinking. These are the labels that divide into groups. “Left” and “Right”, “Conservative” and “Liberal” are two sets that immediately come to mind. There really is nothing wrong with being to the right or to the left, in fact our society and our Church is made up of people from all over the spectrum.

And yet I sense that more than that is going on in many people. If “I” belong to one ‘side’, then of course I believe this is the one that Jesus proclaimed, and the one God wants me to belong to, and that “the other side” is not in the right. It is wrong. Sinful? Yes, many people consider things just that way. I once had someone ask me if going to Mass at a “liberal” church was a mortal sin or a venial sin. What defines a “liberal” or “conservative” church? And why would going to Mass ever be considered sinful?

“Traditional” and “modern” or “progressive” is another way we label ourselves and those in opposition to us. We label people who have a different way of thinking or acting or believing with such disdain. We use these and other words as if we are using foul language. Our face becomes contorted when we dare to let the word cross our lips.

## Fr. Ken (continued from front page)

When I was a child, there was a saying that we used to chant, "Sticks and stones may break my bones but names will never hurt me." It was a simple child-like way to deflect name calling. In our adult world, those names do hurt, and there are even times when we want them to hurt. These labels are used with disgust and even hatred when it refers to the "opposing side" or with care and inclusion when it refers to "my side".

In the Gospels, Jesus taught harshly against the Scribes and the Pharisees, those who were most self-righteous, who similarly used labels to separate themselves from others, to make themselves on the "right" side. He called them hypocrites. On the other hand, Jesus ate with the prostitutes, tax collectors and sinners. He opened his arms to all, the right and the left, those of different cultures, religions and ways of life. Jesus never shunned anyone.

I often feel that we need to get back to the basics of Jesus teachings. It's all so very simple. God Bless you all....wherever you fall in the spectrum as a beloved child of God.




