

## MAY 21, 2017 • 6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER



Last weekend, May 13, the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first apparition of Mary in Fatima, Portugal occurred. Pope Francis went to Portugal to attend the ceremonies and to canonize two of the young children whom the Blessed Virgin appeared to 100 years ago: Francisco and

Jacinta Marto. They both died within a couple of years after the apparitions, at the ages of 10 (Francisco) and 9 (Jacinta), from influenza. The third child, Lucia Santos, later entered the convent and lived until 2005, when she died just short of her 98<sup>th</sup> birthday.

Over the years, I had always thought that the apparitions in Fatima had become, unfortunately, too sensationalized; there are "secrets" that the Virgin Mary gave to the young children. The thought of secrets appeals to the "dark" side of some people. After the rise of Communism, the world was called to pray for the "conversion of Russia"; to pray for an end to Communism, because it did not believe in a God, was not a bad thing, but the prayers often used referred to the common Russian people as "enemies", "cohorts of Satan" and "evil". In fact, as in most Eastern European countries where Communism was present, the common folk never lost their Christian faith and often suffered on account of it. There was a song made famous during the 1980's called "Russians". One line states, "we have the same biology....The Russians love their children too".

As he canonized Jacinta and Francisco, Pope Francis reminds us that we must all have the heart of a child. Loving. Trusting. This is not the first time that I have written this in the past few months. We are always called to go the childlike faith, as the two young shepherds had. Childlike, not childish. Too often I fear that our behavior becomes more self-indulgent, centered on ourselves and not on our Lord. We have a heavenly Mother. She is the Cause of Our Joy. Clinging to her like children, we live in the hope that rests on Jesus.
