

This weekend we celebrate the feast of Pentecost (fifty days), the birthday of the Church. This is a day for celebration. It surely is not a day for the weak or faint of heart. We are called to be courageous. To have no fear. Peter and the other Apostles, who

had been locked themselves up, burst out of the room and out of themselves. The Holy Spirit stirs up air around them and lights a fire under them (well, according to Scripture, it's above their heads, but you get the idea) and they are no longer closed in on themselves. They are set free. The world needs more men and women who are not closed in on themselves, but filled with the Holy Spirit. Closing oneself off from the Holy Spirit is not only a lack of freedom, it is a sin. There are many ways one can close oneself off to the Holy Spirit: by rigid legalism – seen in the attitude of the doctors of the law whom Jesus referred to as "hypocrites"; by neglect of what Jesus taught; by living the Christian life not as a service to others but in the pursuit of personal interests; and in so many other ways. The world needs the courage, hope, faith and perseverance of the Christ's followers. The world needs more who appreciate and put into action the fruits of the Spirit: "Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control" (Gal.5:22).

The Archdiocesan Synod of 2016 calls us to be a Joyful Band of Missionary Disciples. We can be that through the working of the Holy Spirit. That Holy Spirit has been bestowed upon each of us, and our Church, so that we may live lives of genuine faith and active charity, that we may sow the seeds of reconciliation and peace. Strengthened by the Spirit and her many gifts, may we be able uncompromisingly to battle against sin and corruption, injustice and discrimination, devoting ourselves with patient perseverance to the works of justice and peace. May our journey of life be one of walking with and by the Spirit.

### HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE MAY 8, 2017 PARISH PASTORAL MEETING

- The Archdiocese of Detroit announced the Parish assessment for CSA. The original assessment was \$104,000. Fr. Ken requested that the Archdiocese reduce the assessment. His request was granted, and the Parish received, a \$6,000 reduction. The modified assessment is a little over \$98,000.
- The Finance Council approved the Parish budget for the fiscal year 2017/2018 at their last meeting. The approved budget included an item for a position for a Pastoral Associate/Christian Service Coordinator for the Parish. The Pastoral Associate will be involved in Liturgy and Worship, Art & Environment and other Mass ministries. The Associate will also staff an Information Desk during weekend Masses. The job will be posted with the Archdiocese of Detroit, with a projected start date of July 1st.
- Bishop Francis Reiss will return to the Parish to preside at Mass during the June 24th/25th weekend. He will say Mass on Saturday, June 24th, at 4:30, and Sunday, June 25th, at noon.
- According to the decree issued by the Archbishop, as of July 1st, the Parish territory will be redrawn to reflect the addition of 20% of the St. Mel's Parish territory.
- The new Parish Pastoral Council for the 2017/2018 year will be a combination of five to seven current members and five to six new members. Fr. Ken will select the new members.
- In the future, the Parish may host a PIME Missionary for a few months, while he continues his studies in English. There will be no cost to the Parish for hosting the Missionary. He may also occasionally preside at Mass.
- The Parish will be receiving bids for some improvement projects. Projects include adding a sidewalk in front of the Church sign on Wayne Road and parking lot resurfacing.

license plate that will help provide funding to meet the financial needs of mothers facing unplanned pregnancies, parents seeking adoptions, or suicide prevention programs! This would allow drivers to purchase a plate for \$35 with some of the proceeds going to the Choose Life Michigan Fund. Money from the sales would help nonprofit prolife groups such as pregnancy help centers and specific abortion prevention projects. Michigan is the only state along the I-75 corridor to Florida without the Choose Life specialty plate.
