

Prom the Desk of Fr. Ken

You may have noticed that, now that the Christmas season is over and we are briefly in "ordinary" time, the songs we sing during Mass have changed. Not only the entrance and recessional songs, but also the "parts of the Mass", that is, the Kyrie; Gloria; Gospel Acclamation (Alleluia); Holy, Holy; the

Memorial Acclamation; Great Amen and Lamb of God. Normally parishes change the "Mass settings" with the different liturgical seasons.

The one we are singing now is called "The Mass of St. Ann". How fitting for us, in the Archdiocese of Detroit, to sing this Mass in honor of St. Anne, who is the Patroness of our Diocese. In addition, you may have noticed in the back of Church, now that we have two different stands for the vigil candles, one of them is front of the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and the other one is in front of the picture of St. Anne. This is the official image that is used throughout the Archdiocese of Detroit. We are a church dedicated to Our Blessed Mother, and to honor her mother is also very fitting.

Of course, I am not a musician, and cannot answer all questions about these various "Mass settings" that we use. I know that I am very used to the "Mass of St. Ann" from past parishes where I helped out. It was also sung at the Beatification Mass of Blessed Solanus Casey last November. If you were present at that celebration, or even watched it on television, you know that it was a beautiful celebration with beautiful music. The Mass of St. Ann is known for the simplicity and energy that it brings to the Mass.

Changing up the music at Mass during different seasons, just as we change colors for the different seasons and the church environment, can help us get more in tune with each Mass. Although the basic outline of the Mass doesn't really vary, with the change of the music, the Scripture Readings, the colors and the environment inside the church, we can better be part of that Sunday's Mass. Next time, try to pay attention to these things. You may be surprised.
