From the Pastor's Desk

We are already halfway through the season of Lent. Some of us may turn around and look behind and think, "But it just started. Wait a minute." Three weeks from this weekend will be Palm Sunday.

Lent, as we know, is the season of repentance. Of turning around our hearts and our lives and becoming closer to God and his mercy and love for us. The Sacrament of Penance is a good way to do that. This week we are offering two penance services: Monday, at 6:00 pm, for the faith formation students and their parents and the catechists. Then on Wednesday, we will have one for the rest of us, at 7:00 pm. There will be plenty of visiting priests to administer the sacrament and to assist us. If these times are not convenient for you, please check the Vicariate newsletter for dates and times of penance services at neighboring parishes. There is no reason why you can't find one that fits your schedule.

In preparation for the sacrament, it is indispensable that you do a good examination of conscience. Time spent looking into yourself, being honest with yourself to acknowledge where it is that you have not been close to God, what you have avoided doing that you are called to do (sins of omission), and where your selfish attitude and self-centered life style causes you to sin.

There are many different aides to help you with this. Some of them come directly from the Bible. In addition to the Ten Commandments, which is a good beginning but not at all complete, you can read the Book of Leviticus, chapter 19, verses 11-18. It explains the Commandments in a simpler way. Then there are the Beatitudes, the teachings of Jesus to the crowds. They are written in the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 5. There are also a few teachings there about loving your enemies, about not retaliating, and about relations with others. A final suggestion that I have is to read the passage of the Last Judgement, in the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 25 verses 31-46. Jesus is very clear here about what we must do to help our sisters and brothers in need. This is where we often fail. If you have the opportunity, you can search the internet for the painting of the Last Judgement by Michelangelo, and gaze at it while reading the Gospel passage. The painting is stunning in its portrayal of those who will and will not be saved.

Have a Blessed week and you continue observing Lent.
