

Our joyful celebrations of the Easter Season continue this weekend as we welcome some young men and women to the table of the Lord for the first time as they receive their First Holy Communion. What a wonderful celebration not only for them and their families but also for our parish community. I'm sure that many of us remember our First Communion day. Mine was 54 years ago; it was a bright sunny Saturday morning. The good Sisters of our parish school had us well prepared, not only for receiving the Sacrament but especially for lining up, folding our hands and walking two by two.

The Eucharist is such a special gift for all of us. Sometimes it saddens me to see that people don't eagerly receive the Sacrament and all of the graces that come with, and deny themselves the Eucharist. Feelings of unworthiness, which we all may feel from time to time, may lead us to deny ourselves this great Gift from God. Before Communion, during Mass, we pray "Lord, I am not worthy." Our prayer doesn't end there. We also say, "But only say the word and my soul shall be healed." We need to believe that the Lord heals our souls; He is the God of all mercy and will not deny his forgiveness to us. Among all of the gifts and graces that God has showered upon us, the gift of the Eucharist.

Next week our joyful feasts continue as we celebrate with newly ordained Deacon Derik Peterman, son of our parish.





RELAY FOR LIFE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY

Cancer is a word that we hope that we will never hear but the reality today is that all of us have been touched by cancer in some way. That is why the American Cancer Society hosts Relay for Life events across the globe every year. At Relay For Life events, no one faces cancer alone. We come together every year at more than 3,500 Relay events around the country to support and celebrate survivors and caregivers.

Relay is a team fundraising event where team members take turns walking around a track or designated path. Each event is 6 - 24 hours in length and each team is asked to have a member on the track at all times to signify that cancer never sleeps. Cancer patients don't stop because they're tired, and for one night, neither do we.

Each team sets up a themed campsite at the event and continues their fundraising efforts by collecting donations for food, goods, games, and activities. This money will count towards their overall team fundraising goal.

This year the Relay for Life-Westland/ Wayne 20 hour event will start on Saturday, June 9 at 11:00 a.m. and end on Sunday, June 10 at 7:00 a.m. in Central City Park (Ford Road and Central City Between Wayne and Hix). There will be entertainment, games, activities, food, community fellowship and lots of family fun for all ages. We will be asking our parish family to stop by and help take a shift to walk on behalf of our team or take a shift selling concessions or maybe even grill hot dogs at our tent the day of the event. The name of our team is "Heart and Sole". We will have an sign up sheet coming soon.

As part of our 20 hour walk and celebration we honor our cancer survivors and their caregivers with a wonderful recognition and luncheon at the Westland Farmers Market at 11 a.m. The luncheon is provided by local restaurants in our community. If you or someone you know is a survivor, please provide their name and address so we can personally invite them and register them for this event. We would love to see our parish family of cancer survivors honored at the event. You are why we Relay!
