

From the Pastor's Desk

This past Thursday, July 26, the church celebrated the memory of Saints Joachim and Anne, the parents of Mary. As you know, St. Anne is the patroness of the Archdiocese of Detroit. Her picture hangs in the back of our church, above the vigil candles. It is a reminder of the important role that she had in the life of Mary, who is the patroness of our parish.

In the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, we have an ancestral history of Jesus, showing us that Jesus is the culmination of great promises from the Old Testament. We know nothing about Mary's side of the family except that they existed. Even the names, Joachim and Anne, come from a legendary source written more than a century after Jesus' life. We can conclude from the Scriptures that their lives were both heroic and holy. Sometimes we need to rely on legends about Mary's childhood, or make educated guesses from the information gathered from the Bible. In Mary, we see a fulfillment of many generations of prayerful persons. Mary, too, is steeped in the religious traditions of Judaism.

Mary's strong character, whether it be in making decisions, in her practice of fervent prayer, in her devotion to the laws of her faith, her strength in times of crisis or in devotion to her family, shows that she was part of a close-knit, loving family. They looked forward to the next generation even while retaining the best of the past.

Becoming Catholic: What is RCIA?


