

If walking is not an option, you can donate to one of the walkers who are going down to the event. The great thing about this event is that all donations stay with the local Conference. Towards the end of the month there will be SVdP members in the back of church to sign people up, or you can go to our website stmarycooj.org to find a link to sign up online.

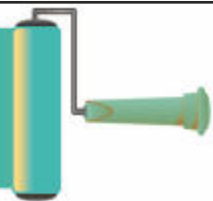
