

In today's Gospel we have a great scene where the Apostles are walking to Capernaum arguing about who is the greatest among them, but when Jesus calls them on it, they remain

silent. I am sure because they were embarrassed. At that point Jesus gives them a response that seems to be a riddle, "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and a servant of all." I am sure his Apostles couldn't figure out what he meant by that.

A modern version of this would be that you are driving in the car and you hear your kids arguing in the back seat about who is "the best." One might be good at music, one at math, one at who knows what, but at that point you speak up and say, "The best kid is the one who does their homework and washes the dishes without complaining!" Now I am sure your kids would be confused by that statement too, but at the core what you would be saying is that you want them to have the skills to get a good job and be successful when they grow up.

I think Jesus was telling his Apostles the same thing. He just got done telling them that he will die on the cross, and rise again. Their world will be turned upside down. He needed people who could do a difficult thing and build a better world for themselves and His church. I think Jesus is also telling us the same thing today; He needs people who can help in a dark time, and build the church into what it should be.

Doctor Prescribed Suicide??? NO!

DID YOU KNOW? What position do U.S. Doctors take on the issue of "Prescribed Suicide"? After much study and debate, the *American College of Physicians (ACP) has issued a new position statement opposing the legalization and practice of doctor-prescribed suicide* (aka, "aid-in-dying", "assisted suicide", "dying with dignity"). It affirms the ACP's earlier opposition policy issued in 2001. The ACP's statement also emphasizes its commitment to "human dignity and management of pain and other symptoms, and support of families." (Annals of Internal Medicine, 9/19/17) We need to remain vigilant and make sure that doctors in the U.S. remember that they should "do no harm" in regards to their patients.


