



The church office was abuzz this morning, the first full week that we are open after the Christmas celebrations. Phones ringing, people visiting, email to answer. As "crazy" as it seemed this morning, it was good to see so much going on. We all hit the floor running when we arrived.

Activities, of course, are just one part of the life of a parish. The liturgies, both on the weekends and weekdays, are central to our life. That's where most of the parish members gather. There is so much more than that which makes St. Mary, Cause of Our Joy alive. In a few weeks, we are beginning a Bible study course which will look into depth the Bible and the Virgin Mary. 
