The responsibilities of the Moderator include:

- Convene the team of priests which collectively pastors the Family.
- In collaboration and consultation with the Family-Pastors and Family-Parochial Vicars, set a common vision
 for the sharing of ministries among the priests. This common vision will be articulated in the Family Priests'
 Covenant.
- Set the tone for a 'brotherly relationship' among the priests and parishes in the Family.
- Communicate to Family priests any guidelines from the Archbishop regarding the Family structure.
- Define any Family-wide responsibilities of clergy, staff, or other parish leaders when such details are not covered in the Covenant or when an agreement cannot be reached.
- Oversee the formation and operation of the appropriate Family consultative bodies.
- Create a consolidated schedule for Masses and other common sacramental celebrations.

PASTORAL CARE REGARDING THE VATICAN'S NOTE ON BAPTISM

In August of 2020, the Vatican Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith issued a response to questions regarding the use of the words, "We baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" instead of the proper form of "I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". The Vatican ruled that the form "We baptize" does not convey the Sacrament of baptism.

In the Archdiocese of Detroit, we are aware that between 1986 – 1999, potentially invalid baptisms occurred at St. Anastasia Parish in Troy, conducted by Deacon Mark Springer using the improper form. We are in the process of contacting those individuals who may be affected and we are asking for your help. If you or someone you know was baptized at St. Anastasia Parish during this time period or you have any questions or concerns about the validity of your sacrament(s), we invite you to visit the websiteaod.org/sacramentsupdate for more information and to submit questions or concerns using the online form.




MEMORARE
