

#### NOTES FROM PAUL

In this weeks Gospel (Jn 15:9-17), Jesus says, "As the Father loves me, so I also love you.... this is my commandment: love one another as I love you." That is a lot of "love" to unpack. A few weeks back someone asked me about this commandment. They were worried that they were too angry to "love one another" and were afraid they were not able to live the way we are called to live. I suggested they talk to Fr. Shafique about their moral concerns, but I will give you my two cents too. As a father of three young kids, I can say that I love them when they bring me flowers, when they are just sitting quiet, and just after they "accidentally" smash something that I have owned longer than I have known their mother because they were fighting. In the first two cases, it is easy to smile happily while I love them. In the third, I may be angary for a time, but under that anger I still love them. That never goes away.

So if that is the way The Father loves Jesus, and how Jesus loves us, I would think this is the kind of love Jesus is calling us too. It is alright to be angry at times, but remember that we are all brothers and sisters in Christ, and try to nurture that underlying love. It might not come as natural as it does between a parent and their children, but that does not mean that we can not find it. So love people when they give you gifts, love them when they are peaceful, but also look for the way to love them when they do wrong. This is how we know that we are becoming more like our Lord.




#### **MEMORARE**
