

#### **NOTES FROM PAUL**

In this week's Gospel (Luke 13:22-30) we get a version of the story about the narrow gate (the more famous version is found in Matthew 7:13). Jesus tells us that many will hope to enter heaven, but only a few will actually make it. In this version, "the Master" of the house is worried about knowing the people who are knocking on the door. Eating and drinking in the company of the Master is not enough for him to recognize them. The fact that he taught in their streets is not enough.

If you hope "the Master" will open up the door for you in the middle of the night, you better have started a relationship with him when the sun was still shining. Even if it seems like there are clouds gathering around us, the sun is still out. Please don't just come to church to "eat and drink" with the Master and hope you are doing enough. Talk to God, the Master, in prayer. Try to love your enemy, your friend, and yourself. Help those in need, and maybe try to "teach" along side the Master in the street.

#### St. Vincent De Paul...

St. Mary, Cause of Our Joy Conference of the St. Vincent De Paul Society would like to thank parishioners for their generous donations in the July yellow envelopes. Parishioners' generosity will help the conference help Neighbors in Need. Many of the pandemic protections against eviction for back rent, utility shutoffs due to unpaid bills, and other needs have expired and lead to many more calls to the conference for assistance. May God bless you for your generosity.

Parishioners may have noticed that the St. Vincent DePaul clothing bins have been removed from the parish parking lot. While the bins received many clothing donations, there were some issues with them that caused the parish to choose another option for clothing donations. The archdiocesan conference in charge of the bins was unable to send pick-up trucks in a timely fashion so many donations ended up on the ground in wet weather and unusable. Also, the vouchers that the parish conference received for these donations are only usable in the SVdP stores that are in Waterford, Port Huron, etc. SVdP does not anticipate a functioning store on this side of town for several years, so the vouchers became useless.

There are two new bins for clothing donations located in the same area of the parking lot. The parish has contracted with a private recycling company that will pay for the donations. Fr. Shafique has decided that the money for donations will go to the St. Mary, Cause of Our Joy Conference of St. Vincent de Paul. Thank you, Fr. Shafique.

Parishioners can still get a receipt for their donations and the proceeds will go to directly help the Neighbors in Need in this area.

#### Deacon James Hensel Celebrates 45 years as a Deacon!

Yes, it was 45 years ago in April 1977 that James Hensel was ordinated as a Deacon, serving St. Theodore's church in Westland. His ministry was focused on the sick and elderly. He served Westland Convalescent Home for 30 years, saying the Rosary on Wednesday nights and prayer-communion on Sundays. Deacon Jim also took communion to Westgate and Greenwood Hi-rise buildings for near 35 years. When Angelia Hospice was opened in Livonia, shortly after, Deacon Jim became their first Chaplin and served there for 15 years.

Also during the 45 years at St Theodore's parish, Deacon Jim baptized 100's of babies including several grandchildren! He also did many weddings, including one of his own children and a grand-daughter. There was the Stations of the Cross and Easter basket blessings that he enjoyed doing too. He also worked his ministry on the other end, doing many wake services for parish members and friends.

Deacon Jim retired from active ministry in 2014, although he has still served at Mass during the Easter and Christmas holidays on occasion. Deacon Jim received a 45 years certificate from Archbishop Vigneron.

Congratulations to Deacon James Hensel. God Bless Deacon Jim on his dedication to God and his Church.




