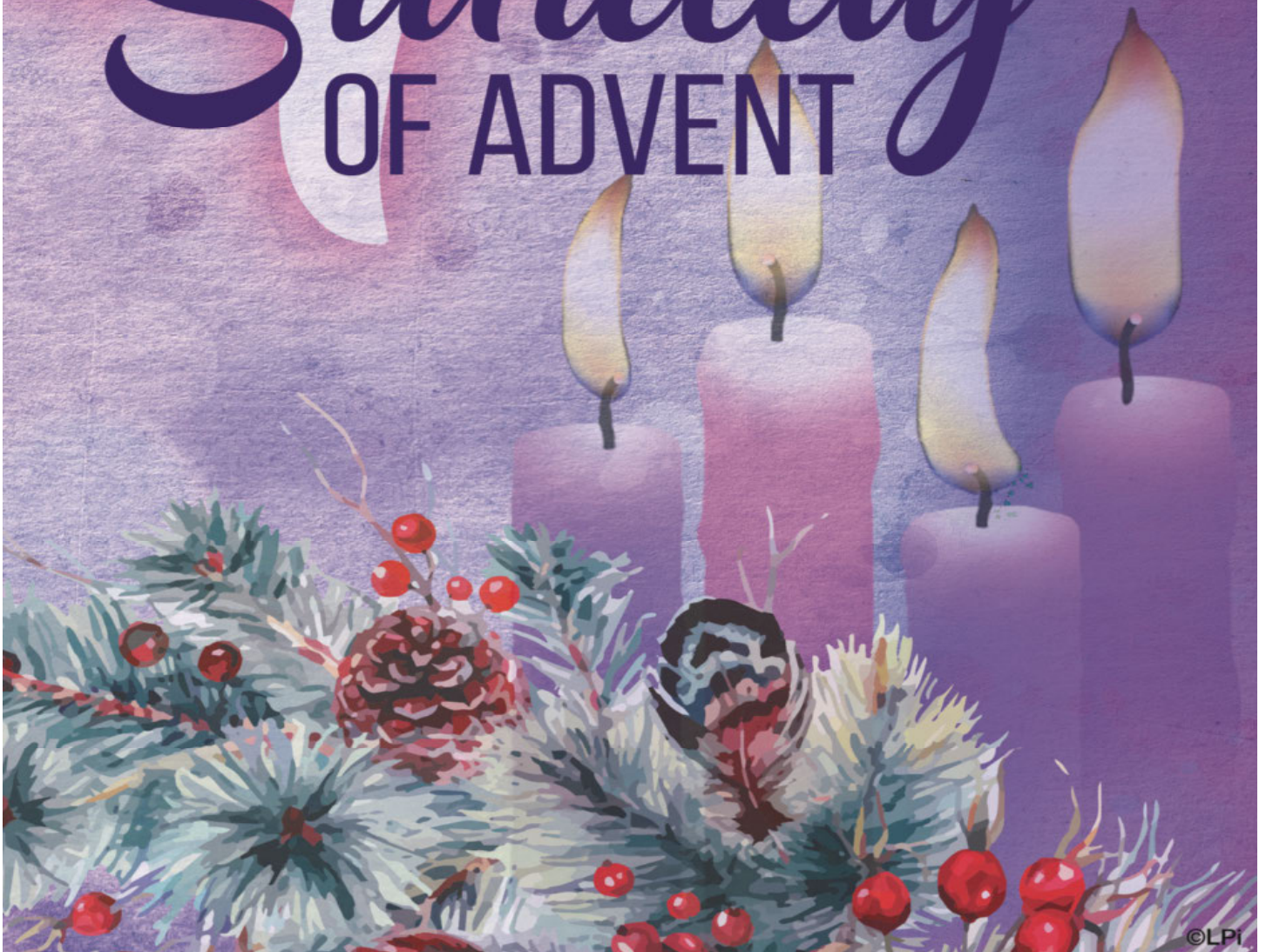

CSA UPDATE

St. Mary, Cause of Our Joy has reached 75 percent of our goal of \$84,284 for the 2022 Catholic Services Appeal. Thank you to the 196 families (out of 734 families) who have made gifts and pledges totaling \$63,555! Our anticipated shortfall today is \$27,013. This amount includes pledges not yet paid in full. Our parish will have to make up any shortfall.
