NOTES FROM PAUL

In this week's second reading (1 Pt 3:15-18) we are told, "Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope." At it's most basic, this is evangelization; witnessing to your faith and explaining why you believe in God. It is not memorizing the bible, or knowing all of the "right" answers. It is just being able to explain why you have hope.

To paraphrase the rest of what St Peter says, 'don't be weird about it, and just do it.' Honestly, even if people think it is weird, still be willing to share. The greatest gift you have, is the gift of your faith. Just like any gift some people may open it and love it, some may bury it at the bottom of their sock drawer. All you can do is offer your gift with the right intention, and just remember, at some point they may find that buried gift and realize what a treasure it was.

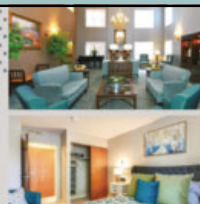
