

The biggest news of the month came when Forgotten Harvest announced that St. Mary, Cause of Our Joy was the recipient of an Agency Capacity Grant. This is HUGE! We will now be able to purchase a storage shed to house all of our current supplies and be able to purchase additional items needed for running the pantry.

A big thank you to all our volunteers and parishioners who help support this much needed program!
