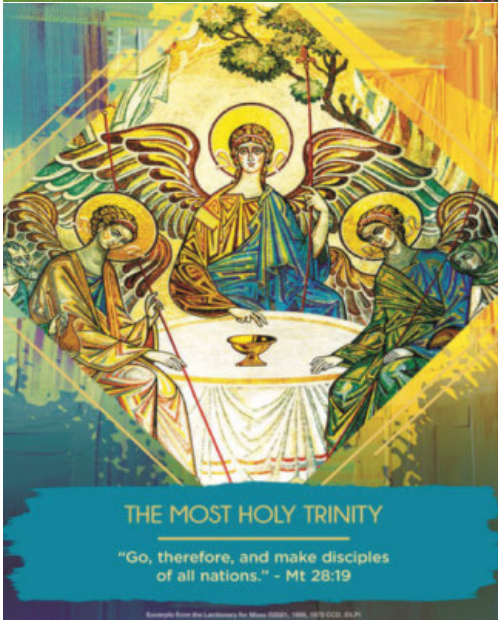

### In Today's Gospel

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. The belief that there are three persons in one God. Although each person is unique, they exist in union with one another. Where one person of the Trinity is, all of the persons of the Trinity are.

Jesus promised that he would send the Advocate, "the Spirit of truth that proceeds from the Father" (Jn 15:26). In today's gospel, just before he ascends into heaven, to be at the right hand of the Father, he tells us "I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Mt 28:20)

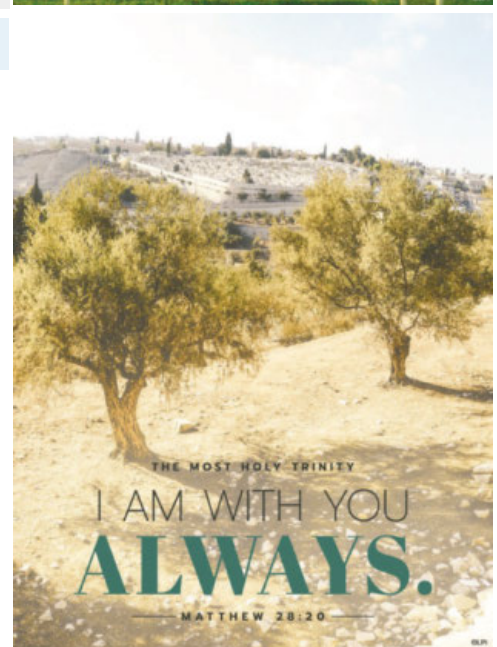

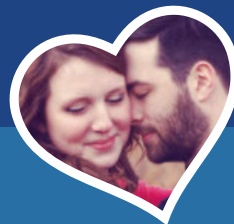
